

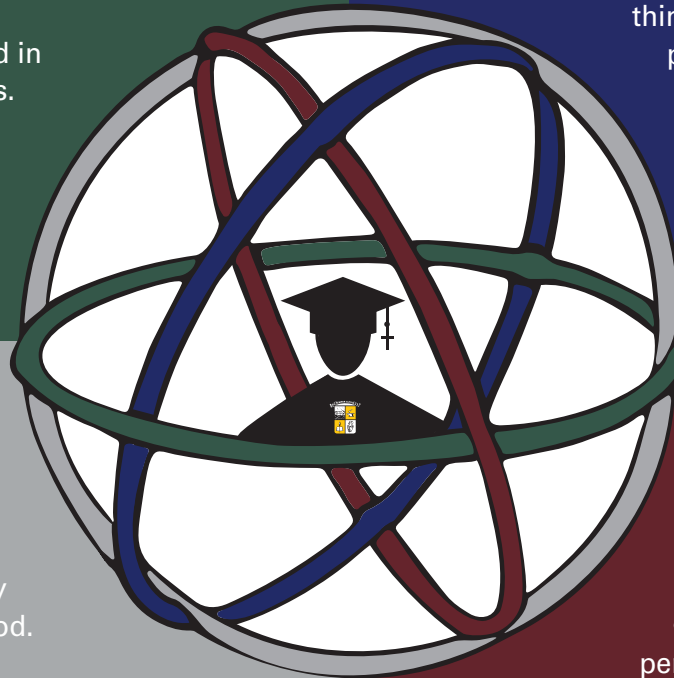
THE EVEREST EDUCATIONAL MODEL: INTEGRAL FORMATION®
