Catholic Leadership Scholarship

General Information

The goal of the Catholic Leadership Scholarship is to promote and expand Catholic education by attracting new students to Everest Collegiate High School and Academy by offering qualified parishioners the opportunity to receive a \$2,000 Catholic Leadership Scholarship. The scholarships are a one-time grant, good for one year and are limited to one per family. The scholarships that are available:

- 1 - Academy (JK–8th Grade)
- 1 - High School (9th–11th Grade)
- 2 - Open (Can be used either for the academy or high school)

Any student who belongs to a Catholic Parish may apply for this scholarship:

Qualifications:

- Students must be entering grades JK through 11th grade
- Solid academic performance by candidate (copy of latest report card must be provided)
- Strong character
- Active participation, as part of their parish community
- Individual participation in annual activity that requires personal service to others either in their current school or in their current parish
- Candidate must meet basic admission requirements
- Candidate must complete a School and Student Services report by NAIS to be eligible.

Process:

1. Candidate must first meet basic admission requirements and also complete and submit a School and Student Services report by NAIS to be eligible
2. Candidate fills out the Leadership Scholarship Nominee Form and mails the form and copy of latest report card to Everest
3. Candidate will follow the Everest admissions process of filing an application, taking an academic assessment and participating in a student/parent interview arranged by Everest Admissions Director, Sue Lowney. Any questions regarding the process may be directed to Sue Lowney at (248) 241-9012
4. Candidates and their parents will receive notification of results
5. Upon receipt of NAIS report results by Everest, final enrollment acceptance will be granted
